

**U.S. SURVEY  
 No. 9276, ALASKA  
 DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF A PORTION OF  
 AND THE SUBDIVISION OF ORIGINAL LOT 2  
 INTO LOTS 3, 4, AND 5**

This plat (in 2 sheets) contains the entire survey record. See sheet 2 for measurement details.  
 U.S. Survey No. 9276, comprising lots 1 and 2, was surveyed by Ernest J. Palmer, Jr., Registered Alaska Land Surveyor No. LS-4575, in 1987.  
 The south boundary, and a portion of the east boundary, of Township 23 South, Range 23 West, 1st 1/2 Meridian, Alaska, was surveyed by Ernest J. Palmer, Jr., Registered Surveyor, in 1971.

This survey was executed by Christopher D. Willis, Certified Surveyor, in accordance with the Manual of Surveying Instructions dated March 9, 1988, approved March 24, 1988, and the amendments thereto. The survey was conducted in accordance with the instructions dated May 11, 1988. The subdivided lands surveyed herein are adjoining of the South Range 23 West 1st 1/2 Meridian and 23 West boundary between sections 4 and 5 was surveyed concurrently by Markwell D. Wood, Certified Surveyor, under Group No. 448, Alaska.

The azimuth was obtained from direct observations of the sun, using the solar angle method, and refers to the true meridian.

The geographic position of the witness corner to corner No. 9, Lot 5, a meander corner, as taken from the record of U.S. Survey No. 9276, is:

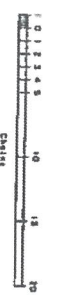
Latitude: 57° 57' 00.00" N 41/18 NAD 27

 The mean magnetic declination was derived from the 1985 World Magnetic Model.

This subdivision is situated on the easterly and northerly ends of a 1/2 mile meander strip from Part 2 of the 1892 Alaska Purchase, Section 26 South, Range 23 West, 1st 1/2 Meridian, Alaska.  
 Above the strip, backwash drains of Dry Spruce falling through a continuation of the meander strip, with scattered alder, devil's club and other vegetation. The soil is volcanic tephritic. The deep, standing (stagnant) water in the survey was by boat and foot.
