The River

The pristine waters and the beautiful natural surroundings of the Current River offer some of the finest trout fishing in the

Midwest. The river is regularly stocked with rainbow and brown trout. From Montauk State Park to Cedar Grove Bridge is designated by the <u>Missouri</u> <u>Department of Conservation</u>as a Blue Ribbon Trout Area. Only flies and artificial lures may be used in this area, and soft plastic baits and scented baits are prohibited. Gigging, bowfishing, and using an atlatl are prohibited. The Blue Ribbon



Trout Area of the Current River serves as the border of one side of the Blue Ribbon Trout Cabin property, thus giving the cabin its name.

The crystal-clear waters of the river provide excellent floating opportunities by canoe, kayak, or inner tube. Put in directly from the Blue Ribbon Trout Cabin property!
