Next door to the Fort Union Trading Post, this Missouri River farm is where history meets modern farming and recreation. Own approximately 181 acres, including 50 acres of river bottom and 121 acres of irrigated & productive, level farm ground. The fertile soil has historically and currently produced a successful wheat and sugar beet crop. This offering includes 124 acre feet of water from the Lower Yellowstone Irrigation Ditch, PLUS a supplemental 176 acre feet pumped from the Missouri. The 4,000 gpm pump and over 2,000 feet of pipeline are included. There will never be a shortage of water! The combination of cover in the river bottom, and productive fields make an exceptional hunting and fishing property. Pheasant, duck, geese, turkey, and deer hunting opportunities will keep you busy all season long. During the warmer months, put your boat in the water just up the road, or fish right from the bank. This farm will not last long! *Note – the home and outbuildings seen in the photos are NOT included.
